I would like to see, within three to four years, at least 60% of shops, banks, Hotels, B+B's Supermarkets, Theatre, Cinema's, Leisure industry ECT displaying a "Dementia Friendly Badge" on their doors and Entrances very similar to the "Investors In People" we see on most businesses doors. The wonderful thing about this idea is the simplicity of it. We don't have to make it hard; we don't have to get tied up in Bureaucracy, because we already have the training information in place!! We have leaflets on every type of Dementia there is, freely available from Big Dementia Charities.

All I am asking is if every business in Torbay will agree to sign up to this and let us do the hard work for them. We will provide the information, we will provide the badge and we can also supply the "Including People with Dementia What Works Cards" which they can either buy for a very small fee of £3.00 or even download free from the internet!!
